- **CAASPP Testing is upon us! Third and Fourth grade begin testing for this week.** Please keep interruptions to a minimum. Please discuss being respectful to the testing environment; if it is your students' time for School Beautification and students are testing, please return at another time. Thanks!
- Please encourage daily student attendance; if a student is out for more than 2 days, a phone call home from the teacher makes such an impact. We are in great danger of scoring 'Red' for the year in Chronic Attendance and becoming a Focus School next year.
 - *Please continue to take care of yourselves—as you know, our general budget is minimal for the next school year. The only money we will receive as carry over will be the funds saved from the faculty sub days. The district will reimburse the funds left over from the faculty sub time—each faculty member is allotted 5 days. If someone is absent more than the 5 days, excluding approved FMLA absences, then the funds are taken from someone else's 5 days.
