**NOTES : PLEASE READ VERY IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

1. In Light of all the happenings around the District:
  - a. Do not lock your classroom doors during the day when you are in your classroom
  - b. Do not keep student(s) in your class behind closed doors and alone with you.
  - c. No students are to stay after school except if in approved sanctioned programs and leave campus when program is completed. The only after school programs sanctioned are intervention classes, Youth Services, YDP, Good News Club
  - d. All voluntary unsanctioned programs are hereby canceled.

Refer to your teacher's handbook for appropriate bulletins for policies and procedures. This is not only about loss of credentials but more serious consequences.
5. Please do not stay after dark. It is not safe. District Policy states that teachers leave when the last administrator leaves the campus. Our hours are from 7:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. Custodial crew cannot be responsible for your safety as they are all over campus doing various jobs.
